ODPP Rape and Sexual Offences Statistics - January 2017

The following data is authorised for release by the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions (ODPP) and relates to the number of formal indictments (*Information*) filed in the High Courts of Fiji by the Director of Public Prosecutions throughout the month. This data is confined to incidents of serious sexual offences only.

There were 14 people charged with a total of 34 separate incidents in January. The offences were rape (28), attempted rape (1), indecent assault (1), and sexual assault (4).

There were 14 victims of the 34 separate incidents of which 9 victims were under the age of 18 years old.

There was one incident of rape where the accused is a 60 year old grandfather and the victim was his 8 year old grandson.

The youngest victim was a 5 year old and the accused was a 50 year old man.

There were 5 offences where the victims were related to the accused persons.
