Name of Matter: State-v-Apimeleki Wailomo and Josua Navaluvou

Names of Accused Persons: Apimeleki Wailomo and Josua Navaluvou

Charges: One count each of sedition contrary to section 67 (1) (a) and one count each of urging political violence, contrary to section 65 (1) (b) of the Crimes Decree 2009.

Update:

The Director of Public Prosecutions, Mr Christopher Pryde, has charged another two people with sedition contrary to section 67 (1) (a) and urging political violence, contrary to section 65 (1) (b) of the Crimes Decree 2009.

The two were produced at the Rakiraki Magistrates' Court today (21.8.15).

The State asked for both to be remanded in custody due to the seriousness of the charges and the ongoing police investigations into the use of firearms.

They have been remanded in custody until 1 September 2015 when the matter will be called at the Lautoka High Court.
