Alleged Para-military Style Training Group Matters Adjourned

Forty-one people charged with sedition last month appeared at the Lautoka High Court yesterday (23.09.15) for mention.

These people are related to an alleged para-military style training group and are charged with sedition contrary to section 67 and urging political violence contrary to section 65 of the Crimes Decree 2009.

Matter was called for Information and Disclosures. The State filed further Disclosures and sought time from the Court to file Information in the High Court.

The State informed the Court that time was sought to consider whether the State will consolidate all matters concerning forty-one people charged in relation to the alleged para-military style training group.

Matter has been adjourned to 14 October 2015 for the State to file Information and to inform the Court on its decision whether to have all matters consolidated.

All have been further remanded in custody except Saimoni Nacolawa who was released on bail on medical grounds.
