### **Alleged Para-military Style Training Group Matters Adjourned**

Forty-one people charged with sedition last month appeared at the Lautoka High Court today (22.09.15) for mention.

These people are related to an alleged para-military style training group and are charged with sedition contrary to section 67 and urging political violence contrary to section 65 of the Crimes Decree 2009.

The State has filed the second phase of Disclosures.

Matter has been adjourned to 23 September 2015 to be called at the Lautoka High Court.

All have been further remanded in custody except Saimoni Nacolawa who was released on bail on medical grounds.

#### STATE-V-ILIATIA KOROLALA & ORS

- 3 accused persons.
- One count each of sedition contrary to section 67 (1) (a) and with one count each of urging political violence, contrary to section 65 (1) (b) of the Crimes Decree 2009. Accused Iliatia Korolala is also charged with one count of sedition contrary to section 67 (1) (b) of the Crimes Decree 2009.

#### STATE-V-SALIMONI SERAU & ORS

- 6 accused persons.
- One count each of sedition contrary to section 67 (1) (a) and with one count each of urging political violence, contrary to section 65 (1) (b) of the Crimes Decree 2009.

STATE-V-TAWAKE & ORS

- 16 accused persons.
- One count of Sedition contrary to section 67 (1) (a) and one count of urging political violence, contrary to section 65 (1) (b) of the Crimes Decree 2009, each.

STATE-V-MARIKA QALO & ORS

- 4 accused persons.
- One count each of sedition contrary to section 67 (1) (a) and with one count each of urging political violence, contrary to section 65 (1) (b) of the Crimes Decree 2009.

STATE-V-MARIQAMA & TURAGABECI

- 2 accused persons.
- One count, each, of sedition contrary to section 67 (1) (a) and with one count, each, of urging political violence, contrary to section 65 (1) (b) of the Crimes Decree 2009.

STATE-V-VILIAME BARAVILALA

- 1 accused person.
- One count of sedition contrary to section 67 (1) (a) and with one count of urging political violence, contrary to section 65 (1) (b) of the Crimes Decree 2009.

STATE-V-NACOLATABISA & TANUKU

- 2 accused persons.
- Sedition contrary to section 67(1) (b) of the Crimes Decree 2009 Urging Political Violence contrary to section 65(1)(b) of the 2009.

STATE-V-DRIU AND NABENIA

- 2 accused persons.
- One count of Sedition contrary to section 67 (1) (a) and one count of urging political violence, contrary to section 65 (1) (b) of the Crimes Decree 2009, each.

STATE-V-WAILOMO AND NAVALUVOU

- 2 accused persons.
- One count each of sedition contrary to section 67 (1) (a) and one count each of urging political violence, contrary to section 65 (1) (b) of the Crimes Decree 2009.

STATE-V-NAGATA & ORS

- 3 accused persons.
- Sedition contrary to section 67 (1) (b) and with inciting communal antagonism, contrary to section 65 (1) (b) of the Crimes Decree 2009.
