### **Acting DPP makes decision in recent high profile cases**

The Acting Director of Public Prosecutions, Mr David Toganivalu, has decided that no charges will be laid in the following high profile cases:

**Sitiveni Rabuka and Sakiasi Ditoka**

Alleged offence - urging political violence and inciting communal antagonism

**Voreqe Bainimarama**

Alleged offence - urging political violence and inciting communal antagonism

**Ili Vunisuwai and Waisale Tikowale**

Alleged offence - urging political violence and inciting communal antagonism

**Mosese Bulitavu**

Alleged offence - causing harm through electronic communication

The police files were sent to the DPP for an assessment of the evidence and a decision on whether any charges should be laid following the complaints.

The Acting DPP stated that after a review of the police docket and the evidence, it is our opinion that there is insufficient evidence to support any criminal charges against the suspects in their respective matters, therefore, the docket has been returned to police with the instructions not to charge and no further action is required.
