ODPP Serious Crime (Non-Sexual Violence Offences) Statistics – December 2025

The following data is authorised for release by the Office of the Director of Public Prosecutions (ODPP) and relates to the number of formal indictments (Information) filed in the High Courts of Fiji by the Director of Public Prosecutions throughout the month. This data is confined to incidents of serious crimes other than sexual violence offences which are recorded and published separately. This data also includes offences committed by police officers.

Cases

There were seven indictments (Information) filed in the High Court with a total of 11 counts of non-sexual offences in December.

Counts of offences

The counts for non-sexual offences were manslaughter (1), aggravated robbery (2), aggravated burglary (1), theft (1), assault causing actual bodily harm (1), act with intent to cause grievous harm (2), breach of bail (1), and breach of suspended sentence (2).

Accused and Victims

There were 11 people charged with a total of 11 counts of non-sexual offences.

There were six victims of the 31 counts of non-sexual offences.

There was one incident where the accused and the victim were related to one another.

Manslaughter

A 31-year-old man was charged with the manslaughter of his uncle. The accused person allegedly punched his uncle several times which later resulted in his death.

Assault

A 35-year-old man was charged with an act with intent to cause grievous bodily harm to a 54-year-old man. The accused person allegedly threw a beer bottle at the victim during an altercation. The accused person was also charged with a breach of his bail condition.

In another incident, a 29-year-old man and a 60-year-old man were charged with an act with intent to cause grievous harm and assault causing actual bodily harm to a 20-year-old man. One of the accused person was also charged with a breach of his suspended sentence.

Other offences

Cash and assorted items were stolen during the alleged aggravated robbery and aggravated burglary offences which consisted of house and restaurant break-ins and daylight robberies.

In one of the cases, a 39-year-old man and a 29-year-old woman were charged with an aggravated robbery. The accused persons called a taxi for pickup and allegedly robbed the taxi driver of \$358 cash.
