

ODPP Weekly Court Bulletin

23 March 2026 – 27 March 2026

Case 1: State v Keni Salawai & Jope Seniloli

Charge:

- 1 count of murder

Two men charged in relation to the death of Police Constable appeared at the Suva High Court.

Keni Salawai and Jope Seniloli are charged with the murder of Police Constable 8012 Peniasi Racagi. It is alleged that between 21 and 22 February 2026, the two accused persons, together with another individual, aided and abetted in causing injuries to Constable Racagi, which resulted in his death.

The matter is adjourned to 8 May 2026 for State file the Information and Disclosures.

The accused persons were granted bail under strict conditions.

Case 2: Komal Sapna Singh & Susana Radinivulagi

Charges:

- 1 count of manslaughter
- 1 count of manslaughter arising from breach of duty

Komal Sapna Singh and Susana Radinivulagi, charged in relation to the death of 3-year-old Elijah Jibola appeared in the Lautoka High Court.

Komal Singh is charged with one count of manslaughter. It is alleged that on 29 January 2026 she allegedly driving a motor vehicle in a reckless manner that caused the death of the victim who was crossing the road at the time of incident.

Susana Radinivulagi was also charged with one count of manslaughter arising from breach of duty. It is alleged that on the same day the accused neglected to supervise the child which resulted in his death.

The State has filed the Information. The accused persons are on bail.

The matter has been adjourned to 17 April 2026.

Case 3: State v Ana Masere

Charge:

- 2 counts of causing harm by posting an electronic communication
- 2 counts of indecently annoying or insulting another person

Ana Masere appeared charged in relation to posting derogatory and harmful contents about another woman appeared at the Lautoka High Court.

The State has filed the Information and Disclosures

The court has also warned her to comply with her bail conditions, specifically restricting her TikTok activity to promotional content for the Hope Carnival only.

The matter is adjourned to 16 April for plea.

Her bail was further extended.

Case 4: Ratu Lote Leweivuna & Ors

Charges:

- 1 count of unlawful possession of illicit drugs
- 1 count of unlawful importation of illicit drugs

Two police officers and two civilians charged in relation to the 4.7 kilograms of methamphetamine case appeared at the Suva High Court.

Ratu Lote Leweivuna and Sevuloni Lubi are charged with the unlawful possession of illicit drugs while Eroni Bati and Alipate Matadigo are charged with the unlawful importation and transportation of illicit drugs.

Ratu Lote and Alipate Matadigo have filed their bail application while Eroni Bati and Alipate Matadigo will be filing their bail application soon.

The matter is adjourned to 4 May 2026 for bail hearing.

All accused persons have been further remanded in custody.

Case 5: Civil Forfeiture Matter

The Lautoka High today dismissed a strike-out application filed by the respondents in relation to a restrained properties matter linked the tonnes of drugs.

The State had filed a restraining order application and a subsequent forfeiture application on the two properties worth \$8.8 million comprising a an area of 1293 square meters, a property and

land comprising of 1157 square meters, in Denarau, Nadi, identified during a financial investigation as properties used to store the drugs. The respondents in the matter are Denarau Fitness PTE LTD, Sam Amine, Rasha Kurdi and Mherina Amahaizabeen Ali Ahmed.

The matter was called today to hear the respondents' strike-out application, however, there was no appearance or representation on behalf of the respondents. The State moved to have the application dismissed and the same was granted by the Court.

The two properties remain restrained following orders granted by the High Court last year.

The State is seeking a final forfeiture order pursuant to Section 19(c)–(e) of the Proceeds of Crimes Act 1997.

The matter has been adjourned to 24 April 2026 for mention and hearing of the State's application.
